

2013 March: Hanz, a student attended ABM school and stayed with Omani family

2016 March: a student from Staatliche Realschule Bad Tolz attended ABM school and stayed with ABM Omani family

Jaiffer and Maxmillian

Muscat - 25^{th} Oct - 5^{th} Nov 2015 Munich - 20^{th} July - 15^{th} Aug 2016

- A one-to-one student exchange at the understanding of GOA and ABM school. More personalised and closer family interaction.
- Jaiffer Al-Omairi hosted Maxmillian Holzinger for about 4 weeks from 25th Oct – 5th Nov 2015
- Activities included closer understanding of traditional Omani family life, Learning Arabic at home and at school, interacting with extended family, visiting the villages and touristic sites
- The Holzinger hosted the Al-Omairi family at their home in Munich for about 4 weeks from 20th July – 15th Aug 2016.
- Activities included closer understanding of traditional German family life , Learning German at home, interacting with extended family, visiting the villages and touristic sites.

Family friendship after the exchange
