WHAT IS BARAZA?

BARAZA e. V. is a non-profit association dedicated to the international promotion of peaceful thinking, tolerance in all areas of culture and religion, and understanding among nations. We are active in various regions of the globe, and are registered as a non-governmental organization (NGO).

"Baraza" is a Swahili word meaning "council" or "meeting place." It is simply a place where people get together, share news and ideas, and try together to solve common problems. In a time of growing insecurity – fueled, among other things, by some media and social networks – we have created BARAZA as an institution dedicated to combating prejudice. With BARAZA we want to build a new and unencumbered community which promotes understanding between peoples, while remaining neutral in relation to religion.

In cooperation with our international team of experts, we develop ideas and projects through our relationships with potential sponsors. We support projects and services that are designed for the general public on a global level, multicultural and multilingual. Through our programs, we are able to reach everyone: from the decision makers at international companies, to parents, kids and educators.

Through the Internet, social media, special events, exhibitions and our network, we inform the public about our activities and partnerships, extend our reach, and recruit support.

HISTORY

The project that led to the foundation of BARAZA and the establishment of this international network is the touring exhibition "Tolerance, Understanding, Coexistence," which was conceived and realized by BARAZA board members. Since 2010, this exhibition has been presented in more than 120 locations in 35 countries around the world, including schools, universities, state and religious institutions, museums, the UN and UNESCO.

NETWORK

BARAZA maintains an active international network of renowned university professors and leaders of transcultural and interfaith institutions, and youth organizations.

The founding members, advisors and associates of BARAZA come from different countries and all walks of life. They work in different fields, are of different nationalities, ethnic groups, and faith traditions.
